

ORDINANCE NO. 205


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.320 OF THE WILSONVILLE CODE, 1981.

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7.320 (3) of the Wilsonville Code, 1981, is hereby amended and changed to provide as follows:

"3. The license fee for the period January 1, to July 1, in any year hereafter shall be one-half the annual license fee, payable on or before January 15th; and the annual license fee as required by the foregoing subsection (2) shall be paid thereafter for each year or fraction thereof that the licensee continues in business in the City and is otherwise subject to the requirement of this Code."


