ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 218, AN
ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF TRASK STREET
IN THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY,
OREGON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has come to the City Council's attention that
there is a need to correct the legal description that appears
in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 218;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Wilsonville ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 218 is amended to read:

"Section 1: The portion of Trask Street in Wilson-
ville, Clackamas County, Oregon, described as
follows, shall be vacated and the vacation thereof
shall be effective on the adoption of this Ordinance after second and final reading as provided
by the Wilsonville City Charter:

A tract of land situated in Section 23, T. 3
S., R. 1 W., of the Willamette Meridian, being
a part of that certain tract of land conveyed
to Phillip R. Balsiger, et ux, as recorded by
Fee No. 70-17235, Deed Records, Clackamas
County, Oregon, being more particularly described
as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a 3/4" iron pipe in the easterly
right of way line of the State Frontage Road
being the southwest corner of that certain tract
of land conveyed by Book 501, Page 413, Deed
Records, to Phillip R. Balsiger, et ux, thence
South 0°00'46" East along said frontage road
easterly right of way line, 476.80 feet to a
1/2" iron rod; thence leaving said frontage
road right of way line, North 85°43'57" East
135.00 feet to a 1/2" iron rod; thence South
0°00'46" East 60.00 feet to a point in the north-
erly right of way line of a dedicated 30.00 foot
roadway and the true point of beginning.

From said true point of beginning South 0°11'46"
East 21.00 feet; thence South 85°43'57" West

135.00 feet to a point in said frontage road easterly right of way line; thence North 0° 00'46" West six (6) feet to a brass disc and State Highway right of way marker on said frontage road easterly right of way line; thence North 0°00'46" West 15.00 feet along said frontage road easterly right of way line to a point intersected by the northerly right of way line of said dedicated 30.00 foot roadway, thence North 85°43'57" East 135 feet along said northerly right of way line of said dedicated 30.00 foot roadway to the true point of beginning."

It being deemed by the Wilsonville City Council that an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final reading and passage by the City Council.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on September 7, 1982, ordered posted as provided by the Wilsonville City Charter and scheduled for second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 20th day of September 1982, commencing at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the Willamette Valley Wesleyan Church.
