

WILSONVILLE POST OFFICE


LOWRIE'S FOOD MARKET

ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE REGULATING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, DEMOLITION, CONVERSION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PLUMBING SYSTEMS IN ALL BUILDINGS AND/OR STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFORE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 8 AND SECTIONS 9.200, 9.210, 9.220, 9.230, 9.232, 9.234, 9.236, 9.240 AND 9.250 OF CHAPTER 9 OF THE WILSONVILLE CODE OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS AND PARTS OF THE ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That certain documents, one (1) copy of which is on file in the office of the City Recorder and the City of Wilsonville, being marked and designated "UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE", 1979 edition, published by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials and as so amended and supplemented by the 1980 edition of the Oregon State Plumbing Specialty Code Statutes and Administrative Rules, be one and the same is hereby adopted as the code of the City of Wilsonville for regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, demolition, conversion, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area and maintenance of the

plumbing system in all buildings and/or structures in the City of Wilsonville providing for issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; providing penalties for violation of such code; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of such "UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE", 1979 edition, published by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, and as so amended and supplemented by the 1980 edition of the Oregon State Plumbing Specialty Code Statutes and Administrative Rules, on file in the office of the City Recorder and the City of Wilsonville, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 8 of the City of Wilsonville, entitled "UNIFORM BUILDING CODE" and Sections 9.200, 9.210, 9.220, 9.230, 9.232, 9.234, 9.236, 9.240 and 9.250 of Chapter 9 of the Wilsonville Code of the City of Wilsonville, and all other ordinances and resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective

of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be in full force and effect, thirty (30) days from this date of final passage and approval.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on the 6th day of September, 1983 and scheduled for second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 19th day of September, 1983, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M., at the Willamette Valley Wesleyan Church.
