

ORDINANCE NO. 244

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.105 (2) (a) OF THE WILSONVILLE CODE

WHEREAS, Section 2.105 (2) (a) of the Wilsonville Code states that the City Administrator shall exercise control and supervision of all activities, departments, and offices of the city except the offices of municipal judge and city attorney, and also prescribes the procedure for the making of appointments to city positions, and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the procedure currently prescribed for the appointment and removal of employees and department heads which now requires Council approval of the appointment or dismissal of all employees, and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the City Administrator should be authorized to appoint and discipline all employees with the appointment of department heads being subject to Council confirmation, and


WHEREAS, Council also has determined that the City Administrator should be authorized to remove all employees for cause.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Wilsonville ordains as follows:

1. Section 2.105 (2) (a) is amended as follows:
 - (a) Exercise control and supervision of all activities, departments, and offices of the city government, except the office of municipal judge and the office of city attorney, and shall appoint, discipline, and remove all other employees of the city. Department head appointments shall be subject to confirmation by the Mayor and Council. The removal of any employee, including department heads shall be for

cause. Recognized department heads include the Director of Accounting, Building Official, Planning Director, Public Works Director, and City Recorder.


