KOPPER KITCHEN


The ordinance remained posted for more than five (5) consecutive days prior to the time for said public hearing on the 21st day of October, 1991.

ORDINANCE NO. 392

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES NO'S. 222, 223, 224, 233, 250, 251, 255, 261, 275, 291, AND 358; DECLARING NO PARKING WITHIN VARIOUS PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY THROUGHOUT THE CITY AND APPROVING CITY-WIDE PARKING REGULATIONS ON ALL PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY UNDER THE CONDITIONS OUTLINED HEREIN AND IDENTIFIED BY THE CITY ENGINEER.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 18, 1991, did review the existing parking ordinances and postings throughout the City and has identified the current process of parking regulations to be deficient; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Commission has recommended that a City-wide ordinance be prepared which regulates all parking conditions as they occur and directs the City Engineer to initiate the postings at the proper areas; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Commission has recommended that the enforcement process be reviewed and the fines and penalties be updated for today's costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There exists throughout the City's public rights-of-way the following conditions which require a unique posting for that area:

Residential street less than 32 feet wide	No Parking

Restricted truck or truck trailer	No Truck Trailer Parking
Time restricted areas	No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Restricted turning areas for trucks	No Parking Anytime, (with arrows)

- 2. The City Engineer shall identify by map, all areas within the public right-of-way where restricted parking conditions exist and shall be responsible for the required posting. The City Engineer shall provide the sheriff's office with a copy of the official parking zone map. The City Engineer shall have the map and the posting updated on an annual basis. The parking zone map established by the City Engineer, which is on file with the City, is hereby adopted and approved.
- 3. Ordinances No's. 222, 223, 224, 233, 250, 251, 255, 261, 275, 291 and 358 are hereby repealed.

SUBMITTED to the City Council and read for the first time at a regular meeting thereof on the 16th day of September, 1991 and scheduled for the second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 7th day of October, 1991 at which time the ordinance was continued to October 21, 1991 commencing at the hour of 7:00 o'clock p.m. at the Wilsonville Community Development Department office.
