ORDINANCE NO. 393

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.320(3) ET. SEQ. OF THE WILSONVILLE CODE TO ALLOW UP TO TWO (2) PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS TO LIVE OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS, STAGGERING THE TERMS AND ALLOWING MEMBERS TO SERVE UNTIL AN APPOINTMENT HAS BEEN MADE.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that planning issues may from time to time, involve geographic areas outside the City and representation for such areas on the Planning Commission will provide an enhanced planning perspective; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds a system of staggered terms will provide a more orderly provision of continuity for the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that provision for holding over until appointment of a successor is made will provide for a more orderly administration of the Planning Commission business when time constraints in advertising and appointing successors cause an occasional time gap between term end and appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Wilsonville Code Section 2.320 shall be amended to read as follows:

“(3) Members of the Planning Commission shall be appointed to a four-year term or until their successor is appointed. Provided, however, members' positions scheduled for appointment in April, 1992 shall be for an initial term of two years and two of the four members' positions scheduled for appointment in April of 1995 shall be for initial appointments of two years, which two positions shall be chosen by the Mayor by lot”;

2. Wilsonville Code Section 2.320 shall be amended so that current subparagraphs numbered (4) - (7) shall be renumbered (5) - (8).

3. Wilsonville Code Section 2.320 shall be further amended by adding a new subparagraph (4):


“(4) The Planning Commission may have up to two of its members be residents who live outside the Wilsonville city limits but live within the geographic boundaries of the West Linn-Wilsonville, Sherwood or Canby School District. All other qualified members shall be residents of the City of Wilsonville.”

SUBMITTED to the City Council and read for the first time at a regular meeting thereof on the 3rd day of February, 1992 and scheduled for the second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 18th day of February, 1992 commencing at the hour of 7:00 p.m. at the Wilsonville Community Development Department office.
