

**RESOLUTION NO. 1504**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING LOCAL DISCHARGE LIMITATIONS TO CONTROL CONVENTIONAL, NON-CONVENTIONAL, AND TOXIC POLLUTANT DISCHARGES FROM NON-DOMESTIC INDUSTRIAL USERS OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM; AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 1267**

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville has adopted a sewer use ordinance, commonly known as Wilsonville Code, Sections 8.100 to 8.152, in order to establish the legal authority for the enforcement of Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) promulgated General Pretreatment Regulations, including Prohibited Discharge Standards (WC, Section 8.114(5)), and Federal Categorical Pretreatment Standards (WC, Section 8.114(6)); and

WHEREAS, Wilsonville Code, Section 8.114(8), authorizes the City's Public Works Director to develop and implement specific pollutant limitations and local limitations in order to control the discharge of wastewater containing restricted substances in to the municipal sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City has implemented an ongoing monitoring program in order to obtain comprehensive data of industrial user discharges, conditions in the collection system, and characteristics of the wastewater treatment plant influent, effluent, and biosolids; and

WHEREAS, the City has performed a technically-based approach for local limit development using the EPA "Guidance Manual on the Development and Implementation of Local Discharge Limitations Under the Pretreatment Program", the EPA computer program "PRELIM", and the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) "Information Required for Pretreatment Program Local Limits Evaluation-Final Version"; and

WHEREAS, DEQ has conducted a review of the City's local Limits Evaluation and other pretreatment program documents, and determined that the documents meet EPA criteria (40 CFR 403.9(b)), and have provided public notice and an opportunity to comment in accordance with EPA requirements (40 CFR 403.11(b)); and

WHEREAS, DEQ conducted a Pretreatment Compliance Inspection (PCI) of the City's pretreatment program on May 12, 1988. As a result of the PCI, DEQ has identified "Required Actions" which must be accomplished to ensure that the City is in full compliance with applicable pretreatment standards and requirements previously adopted by the City Council on May 20, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1267, incorrectly codified Maximum Allowable Headworks Loading values as mass-based local limits. Deleting the Maximum Allowable Headworks Loading from the City's adopted Local Limits is a DEQ "Required Action".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council adopts the above recitals as findings and incorporates them by reference in support of this resolution.


2. The City Council hereby finds that with regards to the control of conventional, non-conventional and toxic pollutant discharges from industrial users to the City's sanitary sewer system, the following local limits shall apply:

Arsenic	0.084 mg/l
Cadmium	0.051 mg/l
Chromium	1.433 mg/l
Copper	1.575 mg/l
Cyanide	0.555 mg/l
Lead	0.462 mg/l
Mercury	0.005 mg/l
Nickel	0.964 mg/l
Silver	0.087 mg/l
Zinc	1.303 mg/l
Non Polar FOG	100.0 mg/l
Total FOG	300.0 mg/l
PH	5.5 to 10.0

mg/l = milligrams per liter or parts per million

FOG = Fats, Oils and Grease
