

RESOLUTION 1927

AUTHORIZE A CHANGE TO RESIDENTIAL SEWER WINTERTIME AVERAGE CALCULATION FOR THE 2004-2005 SEASON.

WHEREAS, Resolution 1620 defines winter months for calculation of residential average winter water consumption as November through March; and,

WHEREAS, the intent of choosing those months is that they accurately represent the demand on the sewer system as little if any water is used for irrigation or outdoor use; and,

WHEREAS, the winter season of 2004-05 has been unusually warm and dry and some households have begun irrigation and outdoor water use in the month of March 2005; and,

WHEREAS, the City software can be modified to calculate the residential wintertime average to be based on water consumption during the period November 2004 through February 2005 and that value would be used for sewer consumption beginning with the March 2005 bills that are mailed in April.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Modify the definition of winter months for residential sewer use to be November 2004 through February 2005. Such modification shall be temporary. The normal period of November through March would resume in the 2005-06 season.
2. To authorize the Finance Director, or designee, to modify the software to allow the computation of residential wintertime average to be based on a four month period from November through February as note in Section 1 above.
