

RESOLUTION NO. 2177

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT WILSONVILLE ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY TO BE RELINQUISHED BY THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE AND TO EXECUTE AND RECORD A DEED DEDICATING THE ACCEPTED RIGHT-OF-WAY TO THE PUBLIC

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation ("ODOT") owns roadway right-of-way on the south side of Wilsonville Road between Boones Ferry Road and the southbound I-5 on ramp; and

WHEREAS, ODOT desires to retain the most easterly portion of this right-of-way adjacent to the southbound on ramp, to be legally described at a future date, as ODOT right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, ODOT desires to relinquish their remaining right-of-way on the south side of Wilsonville Road, to be legally described at a future date, to the City of Wilsonville ("City") for use as future City right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the right-of-way to be relinquished by ODOT and to dedicate this right-of-way to the public; and

WHEREAS, the City is in need of this relinquished right-of-way for future public improvements to Wilsonville Road.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Wilsonville City Council authorizes the City Manager to accept right-of-way on the south side of Wilsonville Road between Boones Ferry Road and the southbound I-5 on ramp, as indicated in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully set forth herein, to be legally described using a center line description and relinquished by ODOT at a future date.


2. Upon receipt of the legally described property relinquished by ODOT, the City of Wilsonville City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute and record a Dedication Deed to dedicate the property relinquished by ODOT and accepted by the City to the public for right-of-way purposes.

3. The effective date of this Resolution is May 18, 2009.

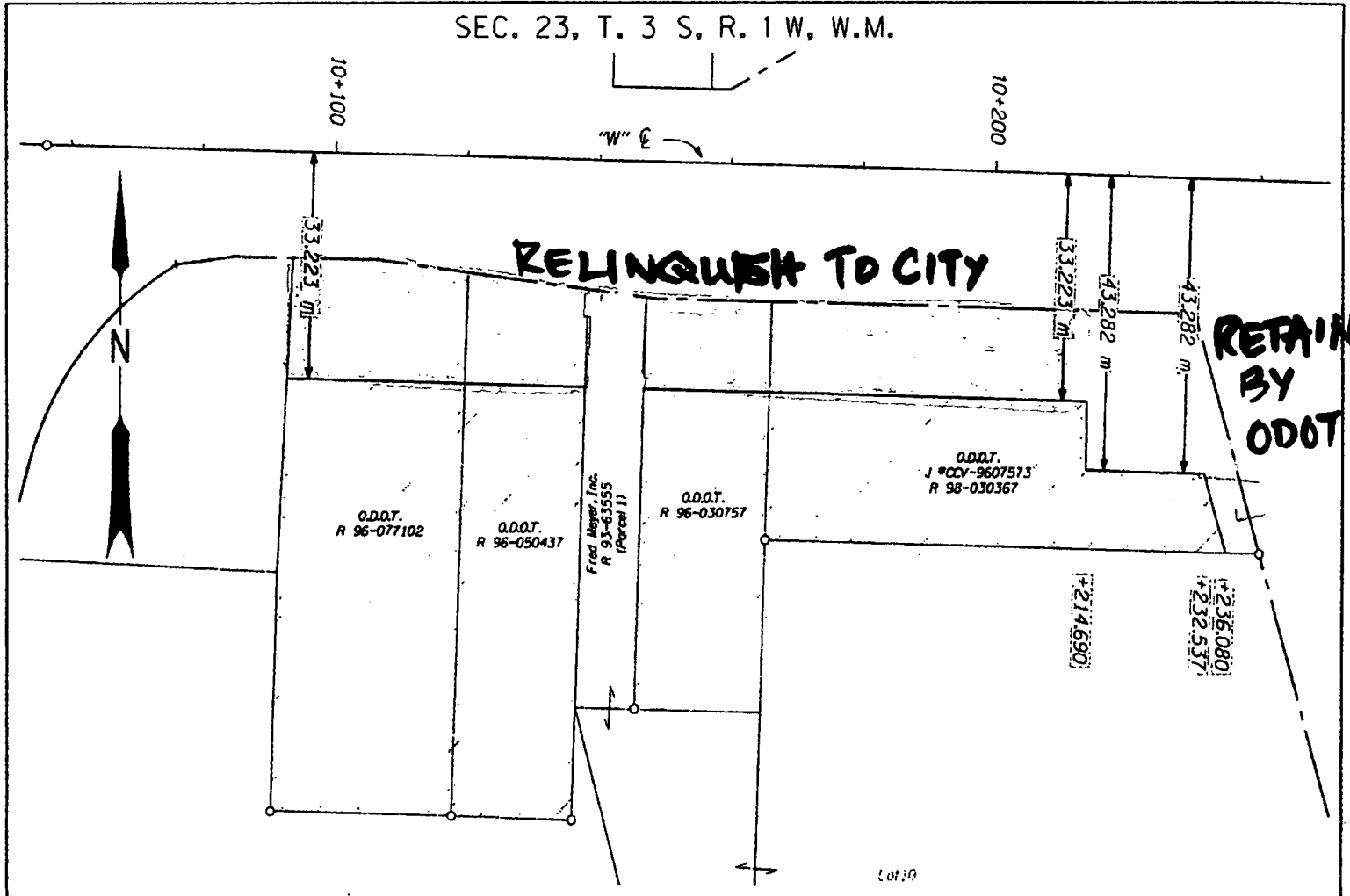

SUBJECT: Acceptance of right-of-way to be relinquished by ODOT to the City

Summary: As a part of the improvements to occur at the I-5 interchange, on Wilsonville Road, and the Fred Meyer Development, ODOT is to relinquish right-of-way on the south side of Wilsonville Road to the City. This relinquishment will occur within the next few weeks. This resolution authorizes the City Manager to accept the right-of-way to be relinquished by ODOT and immediately execute and record a Dedication Deed which will dedicate the property to the public as right-of-way.

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to take the above actions. Due to the timelines of the multiple projects occurring adjacent to this right-of-way, it is important that the City's acceptance of this property from ODOT and subsequent dedication to the public as right-of-way occur in an expeditious manner.
