

PROPERTY AT WATER TANK SITE

RESOLUTION NO. XXXIX

Before the City Council of Wilsonville, Oregon, at its regularly scheduled meeting of August 14, 1972:


WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville, hereinafter referred to as "City," and C. S. Lewis, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Contractor," have entered an agreement under which Contractor is fabricating and erecting for City a certain steel reservoir on City property; AND

WHEREAS, in the course of dealing with a labor dispute that has arisen at the construction site some question has been raised about the right of the general public to be on the property;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby declared that:

1. The City property upon which the steel reservoir is being constructed is not open to the public;
2. No person other than an employee of Contractor or a public official shall be permitted upon the construction site without first receiving written permission from the person in charge of the premises;
3. The person in charge of the premises for purposes of authorizing presence on the property is William Bruck until further action of the City Council;
4. The person in charge of the premises shall immediately post the property as being closed to all persons without the authorization provided herein and shall take any further action he deems necessary, including the erection of locked gates, to prevent trespass on the property by unauthorized persons.
