

RESOLUTION LXXX (80)

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY AS TO TYPES OF FIRE HYDRANTS WHICH CAN BE INSTALLED IN THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE.

WHEREAS, the City has experienced difficulty and incurred unnecessary expense on occasions when assuming responsibility for maintenance of fire hydrants that are installed in the City by property owners and developers. The variety of makes, models and kinds have caused the problems and expense, and it is necessary to establish a policy on such matter. Therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED by the Wilsonville City Council that after the adoption date of this Resolution as last shown hereunder, only the following types of fire hydrants may be installed in the City by either the City or any person, firm or corporation, to-wit:


1. Waterous Pacer
2. Dresser Model 500

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City shall not accept responsibility for maintenance of any other type, make or kind of fire hydrant except the two listed above, shall not be required to furnish municipal water to any other hydrant, and may without liability and at the installer's cost disconnect from the City's water mains any other type of fire hydrant which is connected thereto after the adoption of this resolution.
