

RESOLUTION NO. 214

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS FOR A ONE-TON TRUCK; SERVICE BODY WITH UTILITY CRANE; AND LIGHT DUTY TRUCK

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wilsonville at a regularly held Council meeting September 8, 1981, authorized the advertising for bid on the following equipment:

- #1 1-One Ton Truck
- #2 1-Service Body & Utility Crane
- #3 1-Light Duty Truck; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director did advertise for bids and bids were received prior to 2:00 pm on November 30, 1981, where upon the bids were duly opened; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommended by memorandum dated December 16, 1981, that the City accept the following bids:

- #1 - Eight Thousand Six Hundred & One & 54/100 (\$8,601.54) from Landmark Ford for a 1981 One Ton Truck as specified.
- #2 - Three Thousand Eight Hundred Fourty Five & no/100 (\$3,845.00) from Coast Crane & Equipment for one Service Body with Utility Crane.
- #3 - Five Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty & no/100 from Landmark Ford for a 1981 Ford Courier Light Duty Truck; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Wilsonville duly considered the bids and the recommendation of its Public Works Director at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council on December 21, 1981,


NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Wilsonville hereby approves the purchase of the following equipment:

#1 1981 One Ton Truck from Landmark Ford \$8,601.54


#2 1 - Service Body w/Utility Crane from Coast Crane and Equipment
\$3,845.00

and rejects all bids for items #3 Light Duty Truck, and all funds for the purchase of the One Ton Truck, and Service Body w/Utility Crane shall be allocated from the Water Fund.
