WHEREAS, the city staff has prepared a report on the above captioned subject which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has duly considered the subject and the findings and recommendations of the Finance Director attached hereto as Exhibit "A" contained in the staff report; and

RE: STATUS OF BIDS - Playground Equipment and Picnic Tables

Bid documents for the playground equipment and picnic tables were received by the City staff and formally opened at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday April 16, 1986 as scheduled.

Bid amounts on the picnic tables were as follows:

N.W. Recreation	\$181.00	\$2,534.00
Pacific Playground	\$204.00	\$2,856.00

A donation of \$2,500 has been received from the Boones Ferry Days organization for the specific purchase of picnic tables.

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the purchase of 14 picnic tables at \$178.50 each from Natural Structures, for a total of \$2,499.00.

PLEASE NOTE: The Parks and Recreation staff are reviewing the bids on the Playground equipment and will issue their recommendation to the City Council at their meeting April 21, 1986.
