

RESOLUTION NO. 628

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CANVASS OF VOTES AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON JUNE 30, 1987.

WHEREAS, under Resolution No. 611, the Wilsonville City Council placed a ballot measure before the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville to provide for the sale of 2.25 million dollars in General Obligation Bonds for the purchase of additional city park property and the construction of a new city library; and

WHEREAS, the election of the registered voters of Clackamas and Washington Counties was conducted by mail; and


WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville has received the canvass of votes cased at the June 30, 1987 special election.


