

RESOLUTION NO. 1084

A RESOLUTION FORMALLY DISBANDING THE BICYCLE ADVISORY TASK FORCE AS A FORMALLY APPOINTED CITY BOARD AND RECOGNIZING IT AS AN AD HOC CITIZENS ADVOCACY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council, in an effort to provide safe and useful bicycle/pedestrian access to all parts of the City, directed that a Bicycle/Pedestrian Master Plan be developed; and

WHEREAS, the Council appointed a Bicycle Advisory Task Force and charged it with overseeing the development of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Bicycle/Pedestrian master Plan has been developed and was adopted by the City council on December 20, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now believes that bicycle and pedestrian interests in Wilsonville are best represented by an ad hoc citizens' advocacy committee rather than by a formally appointed City board; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Bicycle Advisory Task Force are well suited to provide the foundation of such ad advocacy committee; and


WHEREAS, such a committee can and should be open to all members of the community with an interest in bicycle and pedestrian issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE WILSONVILLE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Bicycle Advisory Task Force is hereby disbanded as a City board with the thanks from the entire community for its exceptional performance in developing the Bicycle/Pedestrian Master Plan; and
2. That its membership shall be officially recognized as an ad hoc citizens' advocacy committee to provide input and advice to the Transportation Advisory Commission, Planning Commission, Design Review Board and City Council on bicycle and pedestrian issues.


