

RESOLUTION NO. 1396

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE TO LEVY PROPERTY TAXES AS PROVIDED IN THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1997-98.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wilsonville has adopted a budget for fiscal year beginning July 1, 1997 and ending June 30, 1998 which requires ad valorem property taxes to balance the budget; and


WHEREAS, ORS 294.435 (1) requires local governments to take formal action to declare an ad valorem tax levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it hereby levies taxes provided for in the adopted budget in the aggregate amount of \$3,234,600 and that these taxes are levied upon all taxable property within the City of Wilsonville as of 1:00 a.m., July 1, 1997.
2. The following allocation and categorization subject to the limits of Section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution make up the above aggregate levy:


